STUDENT LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

We are committed to providing leadership training for our students beyond the dance classroom. To that end, students may apply each Summer for the following opportunities:

Age 9+ - Classroom Helpers assist teachers in the classroom a minimum of 30 minutes per week and receive leadership training twice per year.

Age 14+ - Classroom Assistants work with teachers in the classroom a minimum of 2 hours per week and receive studio credits in addition to quarterly leadership training.

Age 16+ - Junior Faculty (J-FAC) are able to sub for classes, lead Birthday Parties, teach at community out-reaches, give private lessons for reduced rates and receive monthly leadership training either in person or digitally.

Dancers in Level 5 and up may also apply to be Classroom Demonstrators. All dancers receive training from the STAR leadership training curriculum

PAYMENT

- Tuition fees are paid monthly or annually. Save 5% by paying for the full season by October 31st.
- August's tuition is half a month.
- The dance season starts August 18 and goes through the Spring Recital, which will be in either May or June, depending on venue availability. If the recital is held in May, then May 1st will be the last tuition payment of the season. If the recital is held in June, then June 1st will be the last tuition payment of the season.
- After registering, monthly tuition is paid by automatic EFT, debit, or credit card payment on the 1st day of each remaining month. There is a 3.5% convenience fee on credit or debit card payments. To avoid this fee please pay by cash or check, or provide a checking account and routing number by the 1st of each month.
- There is a \$25 fee on NSF accounts and a 5% fee on late accounts.

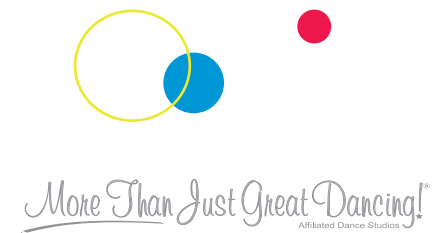

Foundations of Ballet

Foundations of Ballet is a longer ballet class for our Level 3 & 4 dancers who are considering auditioning for MDU's Pre-Professional Ballet program.

Foundations of Jazz

Foundations of Jazz is a longer ballet class for our Level 3 & 4 dancers who are considering auditioning for MDU's Traveling Team program or Senior Company.

Advanced Jazz

Build your jazz skills in this technique only class. Dancers will get to dive in deeper to jazz fundamentals, alignment, core, stretches and strengthening. For Levels 5 and up!

Pre-Pointe

Pre-Pointe is a pointe preparation class for serious ballet students interested in dancing en pointe. Pre-Pointe is a 30-minute class that meets weekly, usually before or after the student's ballet class. The class is taken in soft. A portion of the class is spent doing foot/ankle exercises and stretches on the floor.

Guys Only

Guy Only is a movement class for boys ages 8-10. This class continues the movement exploration of Man-in-Motion with Tap and Jazz with more action, stretching and jumping!

Guys Only Hip Hop

MDU has two levels of Guys Only Hip Hop—a class for 2nd-5th graders and a class for middle schoolers.

Hip Hop

Hip Hop dance was started in the 1970s in the Bronx, New York, and was made of many different styles like breaking, popping, locking, and more. Hip Hop dance is a movement and culture that represents the freedom to learn, grow, and evolve. It continues to grow and change today with dance crews, movement, and choreography.

Ballet

Ballet is a foundational dance form that provides grace, poise, and technique needed to be proficient in all other areas of dance. Ballet classes will help dancers with posture, flexibility, fitness, balance, self-discipline, and self-confidence. Beginning in Level 4 dancers may be able to begin training with pointe work.

Jazz

Jazz dance includes strength, flexibility, and conditioning technique and progressions including turns, kicks, and leaps. In a Jazz class, the dancers also learn many fun and trendy dance steps that are used for all forms of dance. It is a wonderful class to get a well-rounded variety of all dance steps. Great for dancers interested in competing or dance teams in the future.

Tap

In tap dance class, you'll be training your musical ear as well as your body. Tap dancers use the metal taps on the toes and heels of their shoes to produce an endless variety of sounds and rhythms that differ in dynamics and even pitch.

Contemporary

Contemporary dance is a style of expressive dance that combines elements of several dance genres including modern, jazz, lyrical, and classical ballet. Contemporary dancers strive to connect the mind and the body through fluid dance movements. Contemporary is the most popular style seen on So You Think You Can Dance and World of Dance.

Stretching and Conditioning

This class will focus on targeting specific muscle groups with exercises to supplement their dance training. Dancers will gain strength, flexibility, balance and work on cardio in this class.

Modern

A foundational technique similar to Ballet. Dancers will gain strength in movement, learn floor work, and how to dance, and engage their back more through this movement-focused class.

Lyrical

Lyrical combines ballet and jazz dancing techniques. It is performed to music with lyrics so that it inspires the expression of emotions the choreographer feels from the lyrics of the song.

Leaps and Turns

Leaps and Turns is a non-performing Jazz and Contemporary based class that focuses on technique. Dancers work to master skills on various leaps, turns, and tricks.

Acro

Great for dancers who are looking to improve their overall coordination, strength, agility, and flexibility. Students learn and master cartwheels, aerials, tumbling, chest stands, handsprings, and more. Dancers may be rearranged due to Level.
